☐	Review the forum overview, dates (24–28 August 2026) and location (University of Melbourne, Naarm)
☐	Confirm you meet eligibility (First Nations, aged 18–35)
☐	Ensure you can commit to the full program (including potential weekend travel)

Step 1: Apply via the NNTC Website

☐	Complete your application HERE before 5 pm, Sunday 19 July 2026
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Step 2: Register for an Information Session and complete the questionnaire

☐	Register for an online information session and complete the questionnaire HERE
☐	Attend one 30-minute session
☐	Use this session to understand expectations and strengthen your application responses
☐	Be ready to commit to: • Pre-reading and preparation • Active participation in simulations and role plays • A culturally safe and respectful learning environment

Step 3: Application Outcome

☐	Make travel arrangements via your respective representative organisation, PBC or Rep Body (accommodation covered by NNTC)

☐	Complete Travel Form (this is where you can apply for additional travel assistance)
☐	Attend a mandatory engagement session (17–21 August 2026)
☐	Confirm availability for travel (may include weekend before/after)
